

INTRODUCTORY COURSES

2009

The one day Introductory Course, delivered by CIOBS Academy staff, introduces students to the CIOBS and the various administrative distance learning procedures.

It aims to recap study and learning skills and, importantly, also facilitates networking with other students studying at an equivalent educational level.

The course covers a wide range of topics, including:

- Study Skills (including time management and note-making)
- Personal Skills (including memory aids)
- Student Support
- Assignments and Examinations.

As part of their course registration fees, all students are entitled to attend one introductory course. Application is usually made on initial enrolment, via the subject enrolment form which is downloadable from the website.

The Introductory Days are course-specific, with students studying Chartered Banker subjects* and those studying Certificate / Diploma in Financial Services subjects, each having their own 'personalised' day.
