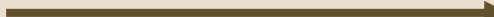

Bank Risk Management (BRM) or <i>Risk Management in Banking under CBD (2012)</i>	1 transition credit towards Chartered Banker Diploma (CBD)	Yes: If you have completed ACBD (4 modules or via transition credits) AND Professionalism and Ethics → Complete Leadership, Strategy and Risk to gain CBD If you have completed ACBD (4 modules or via transition credits) BUT NOT Professionalism and Ethics → Complete Leadership, Strategy and Risk, and Professional and Ethical Banking to gain CBD If you have completed either Commercial Lending or Personal and Private Banking under the Advanced Diploma → Complete 2 ACBD modules to complete the ACBD qualification and then move into CBD and complete Leadership, Strategy and Risk, and Professional and Ethical Banking to gain CBD No: → Complete ACBD by completing 4 ACBD modules. Bank, Strategy, Operations and Technology (BSOT) or Financial Services Leadership (bespoke module)	1 transition credit towards Chartered Banker Diploma (CBD)	Yes: If you have completed ACBD (4 modules or via transition credits) AND Professionalism and Ethics → Complete Risk Management in Banking to gain CBD If you have completed ACBD (4 modules or via transition credits) BUT NOT Professionalism and Ethics → Complete Risk Management in Banking, and Professional and Ethical Banking to gain CBD If you have completed either Commercial Lending or Personal and Private Banking under the Advanced Diploma → Complete 2 ACBD modules to complete the ACBD qualification and then move into CBD and complete Risk Management in Banking, and Professional and Ethical Banking to gain CBD No: → Complete ACBD by completing 4 ACBD modules. Then progress to CBD and complete Risk Management in Banking AND Professional and Ethical Banking to gain CBD
