Chartered Banker Institute Nominations for Fellowship – Guidance Notes

- 1. All nominees for Fellowship are expected to hold an advanced professional banking qualification, including study of professional ethics; demonstrate an ongoing commitment to continuing professional development and act as a role model and mentor to others in the profession. Nominees must also hold Chartered Banker status and have made a significant contribution to the work of the Institute and the banking profession.¹
- 2. For experienced banking professionals who do not hold Chartered Banker status but would otherwise meet the criteria for Fellowship we offer a fast-track route. Nominees who are eligible for our Chartered Banker by Experience qualification will be considered for Fellowship and, if approved, may be awarded Fellowship on condition of completing the qualification. The Institute's Board of Trustees may also, at its discretion, recognise and recommend additional pathways to meeting the qualification requirement.
- 3. Those nominees attaining Chartered Banker status by completing the Advanced Diploma in Banking and Leadership in a Digital Age or a predecessor qualification (e.g. Chartered Banker Diploma or Members course) will require five years' post qualifying experience to be eligible for Fellowship. Those nominees achieving Chartered Banker status by recognition of a qualification equivalent to the Advanced Diploma in Banking and Leadership in a Digital Age (e.g. ACIB or IIBF conversion programmes) or the fast-track route will require to have ten years' experience in banking to be eligible for Fellowship.²
- 4. Fellows shall be entitled to use after their names the following words and designatory letters: "Fellow of the Chartered Banker Institute" FCBI. Fellows who are also Chartered Members may use the words "Chartered Fellow of the Chartered Banker Institute".²
- 5. Fellows (FCBIs) who have successfully completed the Institute's qualification programme, participate in and annually complete the Continuing Professional Development Programme of the Institute shall, for so long as they continue to do so, be entitled to use the designation 'Chartered Banker'.
- 6. Nominations for Fellowship should be submitted on the appropriate form to the Chief Executive of the Institute. Proposals will be accepted from existing Fellows of the Institute, appropriate representatives of Financial Services organisations or a current/former employer. The seconder may be a Fellow of the Institute or an individual who knows the nominee in a business capacity. The form must be signed by the nominee, proposer and seconder.
- 7. All nominations will be considered by the Institute's Nominations Committee and those that meet our criteria will be invited to attend an interview. Where necessary, the interview may be conducted remotely by phone or video conference. Approved nominations will then be considered for confirmation at the next scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees. The length of the approval process will depend upon when the nomination is submitted in the annual cycle of Committee and Board meetings. The maximum period would be six months but in most cases will be less. Nominees will receive an initial acknowledgement and will be advised of the Board's decision following the meeting at which their name is put forward.
- 8. Nominees are entitled to refer to themselves as Fellows or Chartered Fellows and to use the designation FCBI as soon as the Board has advised them of their election to the roll of Fellows.
- 9. Please note that in order to use and maintain their designation, Fellows are required to pay the appropriate annual membership subscription.
- 10. The Institute maintains a Code of Professional Conduct setting out the ethical and professional attitudes and behaviours expected of members. A copy of the Code can be found at www.charteredbanker.com All members, including Fellows, are bound by the Code. Fellowship is the highest status conferred by the Institute and is a measure of the seniority of the holder. As a result, Council requires all nominees to complete the declaration on the second page of the nomination form, to ensure that prospective Fellows meet the required standards of professional and ethical behaviour. In completing the proposal, proposers and seconders are also asked to confirm that, to the best of their knowledge and belief, candidates for Fellowship meet these required standards.
- 11. If information provided on the nomination form is found to be inaccurate or misleading (a) before election, then the nomination is liable to be rejected and, if you are currently a Member or Associate, may lead to disciplinary action (b) after election, you may be subject to disciplinary action.
